In addition to that institution has introduced "Advanced Diploma in Global Business" to motivate students to take part in different activities for integral personality development. The Concern for the society is promoted through various outreach programmes.

#### 2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG):

As such, the college continues with the same programmes but, there is a shift in the annual system followed by the college for last 14 years to the Choice Based Credit System, wherein, there are lot of changes introduced in the form of theory and practical subject structures.

## • Choice Based Credit System(CBCS)

According to the University Grant Commission (UGC) guidelines, Government of Gujarat (GOG) took initiatives to implement CBCS in various universities of Gujarat, and Sardar Patel

University (SPU) volunteered to implement the system and became one of the few universities in Gujarat to have CBCS. At **SEMCOM**, we Implemented CBCS at both the Post-Graduate and Under-Graduate levels for all the courses taught in the college, wherein, the Principal and faculty took initiative at the State and University level to design the courseware and the format of the entire system. Our management Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) took special interest and provided all the resources and deputed faculty members to work with the higher education department of the GOG for development of the CBCS courses and programmes offered at SPU.

#### • Advanced Diploma in Global Business (ADGB)

The college believes in holistic development of the student. With this objective, to increase the participation of students, the college has introduced ADGB. This is a first-ever initiative in the entire country where a college takes into consideration the active participation of students in the various curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for awarding **Advanced Diploma in Global Business.** 

#### BBA (Hons.) IT Management to Master of E-Business admission:

A candidate who has passed BBA (Hons.) IT Management is eligible for admission to Master of E-Business (Semester III).

#### BCOM (Special) and BBA (Special) :

The college took initiative in introducing BCOM (Special) and BBA (Special) at the University level offering 180 credits for three years under-graduate degree programme.

The College is actively involved in designing and detailing the curriculum at the University level. Many faculties of the college are members of the Board of Studies in Commerce, Management, Accountancy, Humanities and Science at Sardar Patel University.
