

TechnoFest Rules and Guidelines

EVENT #1: Best Programmer (Timing: 09:00 AM – 11:00 AM)

- 1. Students must register in team of 2 students only.
- **2.** Time limit for the competition is 2 hrs.
- **3.** Elimination round for in-house students may be conducted if no. of entries are more.
- **4.** Best Three teams will be considered for the final prizes.
- 5. One computer per team will be provided.
- **6.** There would be three problem definitions to be solved in the final round.
- **7.** Turbo C++ editor will be provided.

EVENT #2: Best Website Designer (Timing: 11:15 AM – 01:15 PM)

- 1. Students must register in team of 2 students only.
- **2.** Time limit for the competition is 2 hrs.
- 3. Elimination round for in-house students may be conducted if no. of entries are more.
- **4.** Best three teams will be considered for the final prizes.
- **5.** Two computers per team will be provided.
- **6.** The contents/requirements will be provided to you at the time of competition from which the website content will be created.
- **7.** Facilities provided: Dreamweaver 8, Photoshop CS2, Microsoft FrontPage 2003, Default utilities installed with Win XP/7

EVENT #3: Best Image Creator (Timing: 02.00 PM – 03:00 PM)

- 1. Individual registration.
- **2.** Time limit for the competition is 1 hr.
- 3. Elimination round for in-house students may be conducted if no. of entries are more.
- **4.** Best three images would be considered for the final prizes.
- **5.** 5 images will be provided from which a single image needs to be created. Whole or parts of those images can be used/repeated. Only the provided images should be used for the final image creation.
- **6.** The color of Image can be modified. There is no restriction on number of colors to be used in Image or on size of the final file.
- 7. Submission of Image will be restricted to jpg, gif, and png formats only. In addition, Photoshop and Paint users are required to submit original psd and bmp files respectively.
- **8.** Image resolution must be 1080x720 pixel.
- 9. Facilities provided: MS Paint, Photoshop CS5.

EVENT #4: Best Blind Coder (Timing: 03:15 PM – 04.15 PM)

- 1. Individual registration
- **2.** Time limit for the competition is 1 hr.
- 3. Elimination round for in-house students may be conducted if no. of entries are more.
- **4.** Best three programmers will be considered for the final prizes.

- **5.** There would be 2 problem definitions to be solved.
- **6.** Each participant has to write the code for both problem definitions keeping the monitor (screen) off.
- 7. During checking of each solution, if there is an error, then the entire program will have to be retyped for the next attempt.
- **8.** No negative marking.
- **9.** Paper, pen, pencils or any supporting devices are not allowed in Computer Lab.
- **10.** Turbo C++ editor will be provided.

FINAL PRIZE ALLOCATION:

- 1. For each event, best three teams or individuals will be awarded.
- 2. Individual scores for each member of the winning team will be maintained.
- **3.** After all the events are over, best 3 individuals who have gathered the maximum points individually will be considered for the final cash prizes.
- **4.** For individual points, the individuals standing first in individual event or who is member of winner team will get 5 points. Likewise, second standing fetches 3 points and third standing fetches 1 point to each individual.

GENERAL RULES & OTHER DETAILS:

- 1. The rules are subject to change and will be announced before the event starts.
- 2. The final results and decisions made by the judges and/or evaluators shall not be challenged.
- **3.** Any student found misbehaving or using unfair means will be disqualified from the event and will not be permitted to participate in any other events thereafter.
- **4.** The fees are non-refundable and are one-time entry fee only, no individual event fee.
- **5.** Last minute registrations will not be permitted.
- **6.** Registrations close on <u>23rd January 2016</u> (for in-house students) and <u>28th January 2016</u> (for external students).
- 7. If the number of entries are more, then an internal (in-house) students' elimination will be conducted on 25th and 27th January 2016.
- **8.** The eliminated students and those students who do not appear in the final competition will not be awarded any certificate.
- **9.** Certificate of Participation will be provided after the event completion.
- 10. The Winner Certificate and Cash Prizes will be awarded on 5th February 2016 at BVM auditorium.
- 11. External participants can download the forms and send the forms along with the one-time registration fee of Rs.250 through Cash / Cheque / DD in favour of **SEMCOM** payable at **Vallabh Vidyanagar**.
